The IRS says 89% of households filed electronically so far this year (as of 6/29/18), including 72 million depending on tax professionals and 54 million filing electronically themselves.

According to the U.S. Labor Department, the jobless rate for Americans between 16- and 24-year olds fell to 9.6% in July (2017) from 11.5% a year earlier. That figure, while more than double the rate for all adults, matched July 2000 as the lowest midsummer rate since 1969.
